Dear Friends and Limousin Cattle Enthusiasts,

I hope that you and your cattle are all doing well and that this year is off to a good start for you. May 2021 be peaceful for us.

I have just received the updated 2021 **Nebraska Cattlemen's Classic** schedule. It's similar to last year, with check-in on Tuesday and then **all breeds showing on Wednesday, February 17**. The shows start at 9 a.m. and we're 2<sup>nd</sup> in the South ring after the Red Angus. **Thursday morning (February 18) the Pen Bull Show starts at 10, and then Bulls begin selling at noon**. Limousin is the 6<sup>th</sup> breed in the ring, following Simmental. Pen bulls sell with their respective breeds, and then the commercial Pen of 5 heifers sell after the bulls. I've had our website guy put both the 2021 NCC schedule and the Limousin Bull pages from the catalogue on our NeLimousin.org website.

There will be no Kuhn Knight Cattleman's Social Wednesday evening this year for our dinner before the Breed Meeting. We are working on making arrangements for our dinner, breed meeting and benefit auction.

**Country Inn & Suites** has rooms blocked off for us Monday (2/15) – Saturday night (2/20) at \$79 + tax (14.25%) per night. Reservations must be made at (888) 525-8844 by February 12 to receive this rate. They allow cancellations without penalty if done by 4 p.m. the day of your check-in. They have an indoor pool, a hot tub and weight room available. Breakfast is "grab and go" with options of sausage and egg biscuits, cereal and fruit. The hotel is easy to find – from the first stop light north of the I-80 exit, it's about one block east (behind Red Lobster.) Just ask for the Nebraska Limousin block when you call.
